



SAFETY PATROL

Of particular concern to the Board is the safety of students in getting to and from school each day, particularly the younger children. The safety problem is especially serious at several intersections around the immediate school areas where many children are coming and going to school and vehicular traffic is relatively heavy.

To assist in the matter of student pedestrian safety, the administration shall establish and maintain a school safety patrol at the several intersections deemed most hazardous in the area of the schools. This safety patrol will be comprised of responsible middle school students and shall be under the supervision and direction of a member of the professional staff appointed by the middle school principal.
