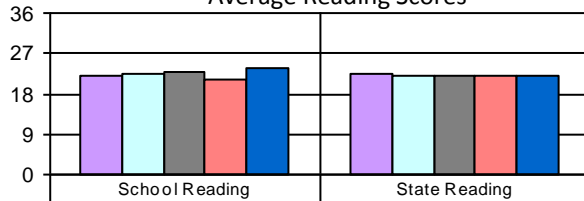

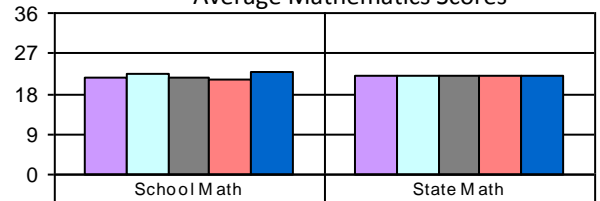
ACT Average Scores by Subject - All Students School vs. State

Average Reading Scores



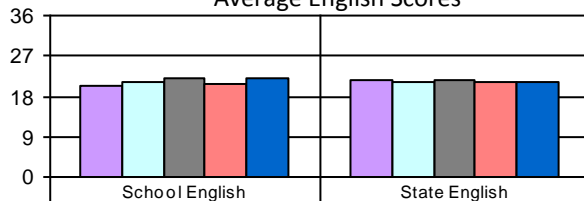

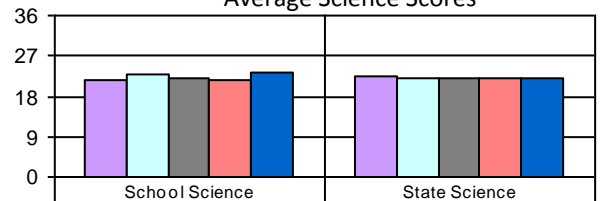

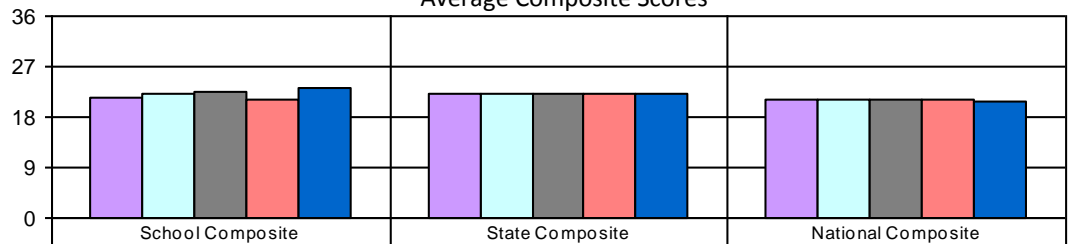
