



PUBLIC HEARINGS

Public education today must have the complete understanding of the community it serves. Every reasonable means of attaining this understanding must be developed by the school district.

The Board of Education and/or the Superintendent of Schools shall, as the need arises, call public hearings for the purpose of discussing problems and needs pertinent to the school program in the district. Special effort shall be exerted in such meetings to solicit attendance from a cross-section of the community.
