

The curriculum of the school district shall be organized and maintained as a unified, pre-K through 12 program of instruction to be operated as a single system under the direction of the District Administrator. In general the statutes, standards, shall prescribe terms, the program of instruction and the curriculum plans. Within that framework, specialized and differentiated instruction is encouraged in all areas of instruction. Teachers have the freedom and latitude to create the specific projects, lessons and assignments that fall within the curriculum plan.
