

FIELD TRIPS AND EXCURSIONS

Educational field trips are a broadening and effective experience for children and are an integral part of the instructional program. Teachers and their classes are urged to participate in field trips to the extent that it is economically feasible.

Principals and teachers shall work together in planning educational field trips to assure that the time spent on trips is worthwhile and educationally justified. The building principal must approve each field trip taken by a class in his/her building. In addition to considering the educational value of the trip, the principal will make sure that the trip is planned with the safety and welfare of the students foremost in mind, parents are informed of the trip, and have given permission for their children to participate.
