The district will provide all necessary instructional materials. An annual student fee will be established by the Board, which will be charged to students at the different levels to defray some of the costs of these materials. The Administration shall establish and maintain a current list of basic textbooks, workbooks, and periodicals that will be provided to students at each grade level and subject area. The principal and the District Administrator must approve any additional textbooks, workbooks and periodicals or changes from one to another and comply with the district's non-discrimination policy. The district shall also provide supplemental texts and workbooks in limited quantities at the respective grade levels and that can be used by members of the staff. Students may be assessed fines for damage to or loss of books. Books and supplies for indigent children residing in the district shall be provided.

When textbooks and other books become obsolete and/or worn out and are to be discarded, they may be given to student at no charge at the discretion of the principal.
