All efforts should be directed by the Administration and professional staff to work toward and accomplish the establishment of IMC's in the schools. All students shall be provided access to a current, balanced collection of books, basic reference materials, texts, periodicals, computers, and audiovisual materials that depict the cultural diversity and pluralistic nature of American society.
