The Board recognizes the importance of and encourages a broad offering of interscholastic activities in meeting the needs of the students. The Administration shall develop and maintain a comprehensive interscholastic program in athletics, music, forensics, drama, and any other area for which there is student need.

All such interscholastic programs must be approved by the Board of Education.

The Mineral Point Unified School District shall not discriminate on the basis of sex, race, religion, natural origin, color, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, physical, mental, emotional or learning disability or handicap. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
