

The Board recognizes the place of interscholastic athletics in a comprehensive and effective total education program. The Administration is responsible for establishing and maintaining interscholastic athletic programs to meet the varying needs and interest of all students in the district.

The Board desires to limit the scheduling of interscholastic activities. Consequently, games will not be scheduled during final exam week on the night before exams are scheduled. Activities will not be scheduled on Wednesday evening. Practice is not allowed on Sunday unless unusual circumstances warrant this. Special requests by coaches shall be made and approved by the athletic director.

The district (high school) will affiliate each year with the Wisconsin Interscholastic Athletic Association to carry out its athletic program in full compliance with the WIAA constitution, by-laws, rules, and regulations.

The Board encourages the full participation of elementary and middle school students in extracurricular programs. Participation in these activities will be voluntary and will be in accordance with established school policies. The administration will assign advisors for supervision of all extracurricular activities. Students who violate school and/or activity rules will be disciplined following the procedural sequence articulated for each activity.

In accordance with Board policy, the school district shall not discriminate in admission to any program or activity, standards and rules of behavior, disciplinary actions or facilities usage.
