ADMISSION OF FOREIGN EXCHANGE STUDENTS

The Board of Education encourages participation with civic or community organizations which plan and execute programs of student exchange between countries and our district. We believe a worthwhile cultural experience can result from this activity. The sponsoring organization will be expected to document the reciprocal nature of the program and must make every effort to sponsor an outgoing Mineral Point student at least every three years.

The Mineral Point High School will accept a total of no more than two (2) foreign exchange students per year. Organizations who wish to enroll a foreign exchange student in the Mineral Point High School must submit all of the necessary papers at least thirty (30) working days before the start of the school semester.

An organization planning a student exchange program must receive initial approval by the administration of their activity at least six months prior to the time the administration will be asked to consider admission of a student. The accepted exchange program is subject to review by the administrator in charge of coordinating the foreign exchange program to ensure compliance with the provisions of Board policy and the administrative regulations.
