



STUDENT AID PROGRAMS

No student in the district shall be deprived of participation in all or any part of the school program because of personal financial need. Nor will any student be singled out or discriminated against in any way because of economic need.

The basic student fee, the music instrument rental fee (for district owned instruments) and other district charges or fees may be waived for these students at the discretion of the building principal. Gym suits may be provided for these students, but they will be on a loan basis only and will be returned to the school at the end of the school year.

Students who qualify for and are on the approved list for free lunches under the federal guidelines of the hot lunch program, shall be considered to be in financial need for the purposes of this policy.
