



**STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS**

Any requests by individuals, groups or organizations to present awards and/or scholarships to students must be approved by the Board. All such requests shall be referred to the Superintendent who will review the request and make a recommendation to the Board.

Only those awards and scholarships that, in the judgment of the district administrator and Board are in the best interests of the individual student shall be approved.

The Mineral Point Unified School District shall not discriminate in the methods, practices and materials used for selecting students on the basis of sex, race, religion, national origin, color, ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, physical mental, emotional or learning disability or handicap. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
