

MINERAL POINT UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT POLICY 421

ENTRANCE AGE

To be eligible for admission to kindergarten, a child must be five (5) years old on or before September 1 of the school year involved. For admission to first grade, a child must be six (6) years old on or before September 1 of the school year involved. Children whose birth dates do not meet the date requirements may apply to the Board for early admission.

A child who is three (3) years of age or older who has been identified as having a disability may participate in a school educational program in accordance with state and federal special education laws.
