2021-2022 Supply Lists

Below is a list of supplies that your child will need for the 2020-2021 school year. Some items listed are consumable and your child's teacher may request additional supplies be brought during the course of the year. We realize you may not be able to obtain the wipes, but appreciate any and all that can be donated.

EC & 4K

ONLY LABEL CLOTHING, SHOES, BACKPACK AND FOLDER

- 4 large glue sticks (Elmer's washable purple works best)
- 1 box of crayons (24 pack, regular size)
- 1 set Crayola Classic Color markers (fine tip)
- 1 set Crayola Classic Color markers (wide tip)
- 1 container disinfecting wipes (Clorox, Lysol)
- 1 extra set of clothing (pants, shirt, socks and underwear) to be kept at school & returned at the end of the year.
- 1 backpack - must be large enough for the folder and a pair of shoes to fit without folding or bending
- 1 large box of Kleenex tissues
- 1 set of watercolor paints
- 1 package of napkins
- 1 plastic two-pocket folder (with your child's name on it)
- velcro shoes are preferred, especially during winter

Kindergarten

- Resting mat or rug. No larger than 48x18x1
- 1 large pencil eraser
- 1 pkg. regular size no. 2 pencils (prefer Ticonderoga)
- 3 boxes of 24 Crayola crayons
- 1 Fiskars scissors
- 4 pocket folders (heavy cardboard or plastic)
- 1 pencil box – regular cigar box size
- 6 large Elmer's Washable Purple Glue Sticks
- 1 set water paints - 8 colors
- 1 backpack large enough for the pocket folder
- 1 paint shirt - no plastic please - (adult tees or shirts with Velcro fasteners work best)
- 1 large box of facial tissue
- 1 Lemon Scented Clorox Disinfecting Wipes (75 ct.)
- 1 package of napkins
- 1 lb. box of crackers (graham, Ritz, cheese, etc., or cookies)
- \$5 to cover media/project fees
- Headphones, digital, stereo w/ ear cushion

First Grade

- 1 plain, solid blue 2 pocket **PLASTIC** folder (no prongs)
- 1 plain, solid green 2 pocket **PLASTIC** folder (no prongs)
- 2 boxes of 24 crayons
- 1 box Crayola broad tip markers
- 1 box Crayola fine tip markers
- 4 small washable glue sticks
- 1 pair scissors
- 4 skinny **BLACK** Expo dry erase markers
- 1 dry erase marker erasers or 1 old but clean sock to be used as eraser
- 1 pair old gym shoes to keep at school
- 1 roll paper towels
- 1 Clorox-type Disinfectant Wipes (75 ct)

- 1 set Crayola Classic Color Markers (broad tip/fat markers)
