2025-2026 Supply Lists

Below is a list of supplies that your child will need for the upcoming school year. Some items listed are consumable and your child's teacher may request additional supplies be brought during the course of the year.

If this would cause a hardship for your family please reach out to the office.

EC & 4K

ONLY LABEL CLOTHING, SHOES, BACKPACK AND FOLDER

- 3 large glue sticks (Elmer's washable purple works best)
- 1 box of crayons (24 pack, regular size)
- 1 set Crayola Classic Color markers (fine tip)
- 1 set Crayola Classic Color markers (wide tip)
- 1 container disinfecting wipes (Clorox, Lysol)
- 1 box of Kleenex
- 2 Boxes of Crackers (Goldfish, Ritz, Cheez It)
- 1 extra set of clothing (pants, shirt, socks and underwear) to be kept at school & returned at the end of the year.
- 1 backpack - must be large enough for the folder and a pair of shoes to fit without folding or bending
- 1 set of watercolor paints
- 1 package of napkins
- 1 plastic two-pocket folder (with your child's name on it)
- velcro shoes are preferred, especially during winter

Kindergarten

- Resting mat or rug. No larger than 48x18x1
- 1 large pencil eraser
- 3 no. 2 pencils (prefer Ticonderoga)
- 3 boxes of 24 Crayola crayons
- 1 Fiskars scissors
- 2 pocket folders (heavy cardboard or plastic)
- 1 pencil box – regular cigar box size
- 8-10 large Elmer's Washable Purple Glue Sticks
- 1 set water paints - 8 colors
- 1 set Crayola Markers - 10 colors
- 1 backpack large enough for the pocket folder
- 1 paint shirt - no plastic please - (adult tees or shirts with Velcro fasteners work best)
- 1 large box of facial tissue
- 2 Lemon Scented Clorox Disinfecting Wipes (75 ct.)
- 1 package of napkins
- 2 lg. boxes of crackers (graham, Ritz, cheese, etc., or cookies)
- \$5 to cover media/project fees
- 1 set of children's headphones (wired please, no bluetooth).
- 1 pkg. of 4 Expo markers

Please label folders, scissors and headphones.

Please label your child's backpack & clothing.

First Grade

- 2 boxes of 24 crayons
- 2 boxes Crayola broad tip markers
- 2 boxes Crayola fine tip markers
- 4 small washable glue sticks
- 1 pair scissors
- 4 skinny **BLACK** Expo dry erase markers
- 1 1" inch any color binder with a clear pocket on the cover
- 1 set of children's headphones (no earbuds)
- 1 pair old gym shoes to keep at school
- 1 roll paper towels
- 1 Clorox-type Disinfectant Wipes (75 ct)
- 1 box of kleenexes

Please label, scissors and headphones.

No backpacks with wheels (they won't fit in the cubbies)

Second Grade

- 1 plastic, 2 pocket folder, no prongs
- 1 plastic folder with CLEAR front pocket (OR \$3.00 to cover the cost of one)
- 1 Composition notebook/wide rule
- 3 **large** boxes of facial tissue
- 24 plain yellow sharpened pencils (Ticonderoga lasts the longest)
- 1 letter-size clipboard
- 2 boxes of 24 crayons
- 1 pack of colored pencils
- 1 pack of thin twistables
- 6 **large** Elmer's Glue Sticks
- 1" clear cover binder
- 5 Fine tip multi color dry erase markers
- 4 Fine tip highlighters/assorted colors
- Soft pencil pouch - NO Pop-Its
- 2 rolls of paper towels
- 1 set Crayola Classic Color Markers
- 2 Clorox-type Disinfectant Wipes
- 1 pair 6" scissors
- 24 pencil top erasers
- 1 set Crayola washable watercolors
- Headphones (not earbuds)

Third Grade

- 1 fine-tip black Sharpie
- 2 standard-size pencil pouches (no plastic boxes)
- 3 large Elmer's washable glue sticks
- 1 pair of 7" scissors, pointed tip
- 1 solid red plastic folder
- 1 solid blue plastic folder
- 1 plastic folder (any color or design)
- 4 highlighters (multi-color pack)
- 1 spiral notebook, wide-ruled
- 3 large boxes of facial tissue
- 2 large containers disinfecting wipes
- Wired headphones or earbuds (no bluetooth)
- Backpack/book bag (labeled)

- 4-pack thick dry erase markers
- 7" scissors – junior size
- 24-36 #2 **sharpened** pencils or .7mm mechanical pencils (with refills)
- 1 highlighter
- 2 red pens
- 1 package of pencil top erasers
- 1 plastic pencil box
- 3 composition notebooks, **WIDE-**ruled, in different colors
- 1 notebook, **WIDE-**ruled
- 3 – 2 pocket heavy duty plastic folders (like Five Star), with a small inside pocket, in different colors
- 1 letter-size clipboard with a low profile (flat) metal clip
- 1 large box of facial tissue
- 1 large container disinfecting wipes
- Headphones/earbuds, not bluetooth
- Backpack/book-bag (labeled)

- 1 large pink eraser
- 6 dry erase markers

- 1 composition notebook
- 3 plastic pocket folders
- Large zippered pencil pouch (larger than 10 x 6)
- Colored pencils - 12 count
- Fine line Crayola markers - 10 count
- 3 large Elmer's Glue Sticks
- 2 fine-tipped black markers
- 1 yellow highlighter
- Post-it notes
- 1 large box of facial tissue
- Backpack or book bag
- 2 containers disinfecting wipes
