

A formal graduation ceremony shall be held at the conclusion of each school year to honor those students who have met established graduation requirements. The Board feels that the graduation is for the students and should be planned and organized according to the wishes of the students with approval of the class advisor and principal. Accordingly, input should be sought from graduates relative to planning the ceremony with the assistance of professional personnel.

Attendance of graduates at the ceremony shall be optional. The date for the graduation ceremony shall be established through the Board's approval of a school calendar. The Board as comprised prior to spring elections shall be the Board recognized at commencement exercises and the President from this Board shall preside at the commencement.

Any active school board member during the school year may be allowed to participate in diploma distribution.
