USE OF COPYRIGHTED MATERIALS

Policy 361.2

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The Board of Education prohibits students and all district staff from duplicating copyrighted materials not specifically allowed by: 1) the copyright law, 2) fair use guidelines, 3) licenses or contractual agreements, or 4) other permissions from authors or publications. Those who violate the copyright law do so at their own risk and assume all liability for their actions. They may also be subject to disciplinary action for willful infringement of the law or for using district equipment for duplication of prohibited materials. The School District of Mineral Point will comply with the requirements of the U.S. Copyright Law.

The District Administrator and administrative team shall be responsible for establishing and implementing appropriate procedures that enforce this policy at the building level.
