STUDENT CONDUCT AND STUDENT TRANSPORTATION

Paramount in the district's student transportation program is the safety of the students. Students have an important responsibility in the matter of safety by their conduct while riding school buses.

The administration is responsible for compiling a list of rules and regulations relative to student bus behavior. Copies of this list shall be distributed to each student who rides a bus and he/she will be expected to adhere to and follow these rules and regulations.

The cooperation of all bus drivers is necessary in informing the schools of misbehavior or infraction of rules on part of individual students. All such infractions will be immediately reported to the administration who shall take necessary action to correct the infractions.

The administration is delegated the authority to prohibit a student from riding the school bus if the student's misbehavior is a hazard to others on the bus. In such cases, parents will be notified and students will be afforded due process.
