

MINERAL POINT UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT POLICY 443.6

STUDENT USE OF BEEPERS

Students are prohibited at all times from using or possessing an electronic pager or twoway communication device or system while on school district property, including but not limited to, school buildings, school sites, school district owned-vehicles, on premises, in vehicles rented or leased by or under the control of the Mineral Point Unified School District or when off school premises while participating in any curricular or extracurricular program sponsored by the district.

An exemption to this policy may be allowed for the use or possession of such a device if the Board of Education's designee (building principal or superintendent) determines that the device is to be used for or is possessed for a medical school, educational, vocational or other legitimate use and permission us granted by the designee in writing.

The Board of Education shall provide each pupil with a copy of this policy annually and shall submit a copy of the regulation to the State Superintendent when the policy is first adopted and upon any future amendments or revisions.
