STUDENT CONDUCT

The Mineral Point Board of Education does not condone the use of in appropriate language, gestures or other types of inappropriate student conduct. The manner in which such incidents are handled by school personnel will vary according to the circumstances surrounding the incident and previous past practice. The administration shall make a concerted effort to communicate rules per student conduct to the student body each year.

The Mineral Point Unified School District shall not discriminate in standards and rules of behavior, including student harassment on the basis of sex, race, religion, national origin, color ancestry, creed, pregnancy, marital or parental status, sexual orientation, physical, mental, emotional or learning disability or handicap. Discrimination complaints shall be processed in accordance with established procedures.
