



STAFF INVOLVEMENT IN DECISION-MAKING

The Board of Education recognizes the value of school employees and appreciates their input in decisions that could improve the district and in difficult decisions where the goal is to minimize the adverse affect on the district.

Employees with ideas for improving the district or saving the district money are encouraged to make their ideas known by communicating them with the building principal or the District Administrator. The District Administrator should develop channels to encourage employees to communicate their thoughts regarding the school's operation. The District Administrator shall weigh employees input with care and shall keep the Board informed.

In the development of rules, regulations and arrangements for the operation of the school system, the District Administrator shall include in the planning stage, whenever feasible, those employees who will be affected by such provisions.

Employees are encouraged and welcome to attend all public school board meetings.
