

MINERAL POINT UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT POLICY 753-Rule

STUDENT TRANSPORTATION, USE OF PRIVATELY-OWNED VEHICLES

The Board recognizes the need for the use of privately-owned vehicles for school events from time to time. To safeguard the district, employees, and students in matters of liability, particularly as this relates to an individual transporting a student or students, the following shall be observed:

- 1. To use a private vehicle for school purposes, the individual must have the written permission of the superintendent or his or her designee.
- 2. This permission may be in the form of a standing permit for employees who use their own cars regularly for school purposes. The permit shall state the particular purpose and whether it includes transportation of students.
- 3. For all special trips involving students, including field trips, a special permit must be obtained in advance for the specific trip.
- 4. Written permission for vehicle use must be obtained at least 24 hours before the intended use.
- 5. The operator shall not have been convicted of reckless driving, operating a motor vehicle while under the influence of an intoxicant or a controlled substance or any other offenses which resulted in a mandatory revocation of the individual's operator license within the last two (2) years.
- 6. The operator shall possess no physical or mental disability which would impair the safe operation of the vehicle.
- 7. The operator shall possess insurance for the vehicle to be used, including liability insurance and collision insurance. Proof of insurance may be requested prior to approval.
