USE OF PRIVATELY-OWNED VEHICLES TO TRANSPORT STUDENTS

The School Board recognizes the need for some school employees to use their own motor vehicles for school purposes regularly or occasionally. To safeguard the district, employees and students in matters of liability, the District Administrator shall establish the necessary rules and regulations.

The School Board also recognizes the need, from time to time, to transport students in privately-owned vehicles which may be operated by a non-employee. Such instances will also be included under the rules and regulations referred to in this policy.

Privately-owned vehicles may be used to transport students only if all state law requirements are met.
