In-Person Learning Safety Important Notes

- Masks will be required to be worn at all times. A mask when worn correctly will cover both the nose and mouth.
- Classrooms will be cleaned daily at the end of the day.
- Hand sanitizing stations will be placed throughout the building and each classroom will have bottles of hand sanitizer available.
- Due to the number of students in the building, **social distancing guidelines will not be followed** at all times. Students will most likely be within 6 feet of each other within a classroom setting, during lunch, and passing times. Students will be considered a close contact if they are within 6 feet of each other in a classroom, at lunch, or if identified by the school nurse.
- With the shortened passing time, desks/tables will not be wiped down in between classes.
- In order for science classes to complete labs and experiments, students will need to be placed into groups to work. Social distancing is going to be limited during these times.
- Seating charts will be required for all classes.
- Music classes will also occur with limited social distancing due to the number of students participating.
 Music classrooms will be using air purifiers to circulate the air within the classroom while performing.
- Lunch will be served in the cafeteria and the small gym to provide more space.
- Study hall groups will be spaced out across the library (and blue room if needed).
- Hall lockers will be used for coats and gym bags. Students will be allowed to use backpacks to carry materials from class to class and to minimize the risk of students gathering around lockers.
- Locker Rooms will be used for students to change into their gym clothes.
- Weight Room/Wrestling Room will be utilized as a classroom space for Physical Education.
