

## Our History

During the 2016-2017 school year, 24 students from 7 school districts participated in the program.

- ▶ 100% of eligible students met their local graduation requirements.
- ▶ 7 students applied for and were admitted into Southwest Technical College for fall 2017 classes.
- ▶ 8 students enrolled in the Workforce Innovations & Opportunities Act, which allocates up to \$10,000 per student in post-secondary education.
- ▶ 8 students participated in paid work experience and earned school elective credit.
- ▶ 4 students completed dual high school math classes, earning SWTC Applied Math credit free.

## Wondering if your student is right for our program?

Students who excel in our program have some common traits:

- 1. Self-guided.** Once a routine has been established, students who can independently transition among coursework find the most success.
- 2. Engaged.** Personalized learning requires students to be engaged in their education. Students who are engaged in their goal setting accomplish more than those who aren't.
- 3. Desire.** Education in a non-traditional environment is a choice, not a consequence. Students participating in any aspect of our program must have the desire to be here. For this reason, we do not allow school districts to unilaterally place students.
