WONDERING IF YOUR STUDENT IS RIGHT FOR OUR PROGRAM?

Students who excel in our program have some common traits:

- 1. Self-guided.** Once a routine has been established, students who can independently transition among coursework find the most success.
- 2. Engaged.** Personalized learning requires students to be engaged in their education. Students who are engaged in their goal-setting accomplish more than those who aren't.
- 3. Desire.** Education in a non-traditional environment is a choice, not a consequence. Students participating in any aspect of our program must have the desire to be here. For this reason, students are involved in meetings from the beginning. Students can not be placed in the program, they must be part of the team decision-making process.



OUR HISTORY

The Options in Education program began during the 2016-2017 school year with 24 students from 7 school districts. Since that time, we have had over 75 students graduate from their local high schools. Our success rate continues to be 100% because of the individualized approach we are able to offer. Graduates go on to post-secondary schools or workforce placements. Each year, we have students participate in dual-enrollment classes, allowing them to earn college credit while in high school.
