## **GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS**

The following are the credit requirements for obtaining a diploma from Mineral Point High School.

- 4 credits of Language Arts, including writing composition
- 3 credits of Math
- 3 credits of Science
- 4 credits of Social Studies that must include Modern American History and Social Issues and Government.
- 1.5 credits of Physical Education
- .5 credit of Health (state requires .5 for grades 7-12)
- .5 credit of Personal Finance
- Students will be required to submit an electronic portfolio
- at least 7.5 credits of electives
- Total credits required to earn a diploma are 24

All students will be scheduled for minimally 6 credits per year and are encouraged to take seven classes per semester. Exceptions to this rule will be granted on an individual basis in accordance with a doctor's order, I.E.P., At-Risk Plan, or permission of the school counselor.

Students who transfer into the district must meet the credit requirements of Mineral Point Unified Schools on a prorated basis.
