THE TIME IS NOW TO FINISH WHAT WAS STARTED

PROJECT HISTORY

In **1994** a referendum was passed for the purposes of paying the cost of acquiring land; constructing a new grade 6-12 facility and related site work; remodeling, maintaining and renovating the Mineral Point Elementary School; and acquiring equipment and furnishings. The related site work on the plans included a stadium evidenced by the installation of the light poles with no lights as part of the referendum dollars spent. For almost two decades the district had been unable to implement the relocation of the field to the high school. The district was also unable to invest in infrastructure and related improvements at the elementary site. This had created baseball and football programs with fields that do not meet NFHS standards for regulation fields, inability to host WIAA post-season events, and overall safety issues. Before the district made a significant investment in a site to remedy the current situation, a determination was made that the high school stadium site should be the eventual location and investment at the elementary site should be kept to a minimum.

PROJECT FUTURE

Jump to **2016**, when a Stadium Project Steering Committee was formed to raise money to make the site playable and safe. The Project Committee proudly accomplished those first set of goals:

- Create a safe community space for activities.
- Ensure access to events for those with disabilities.
- Build a facility that will benefit generations of students and community members.
- Have a facility capable of hosting post-season games.

Now in **2024**, the Committee would like to fulfill the next phase of this project which consists of:

- **Skirting to enclose home bleachers for storage.**
- **Visitor bleachers, elevated and ADA accessible.**
- **Perimeter fencing around the field.**

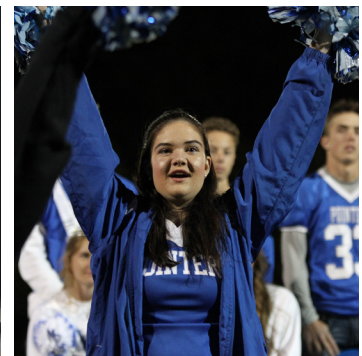
PROJECT FUNDING

The overwhelming majority of the project was funded using private funds. The school district also recognized ownership in the old stadium located at the elementary school and the related routine maintenance required. In partnership with the community, the district made funding available for relocating the stadium at a comparable amount to the money that would have been budgeted to perform routine maintenance on the existing stadium.

We are looking for support for this last push which completes the field and enhances the experience for spectators for sporting, school, and community events.

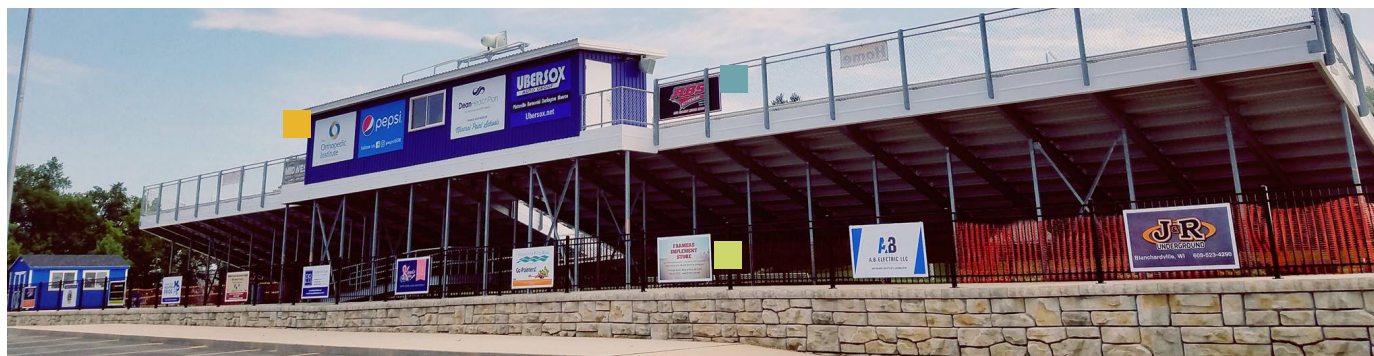
