



## **COVID-19 Reopening Guidance: Use of MPUSD Classroom Facilities 2020-2021**

The following guidelines are to help ensure student and advisor safety for any school sponsored activity in any MPUSD classroom facility:

- Participation in practices, activities, meetings is voluntary. Participants are limited to MPHS students and advising staff. A waiver must be signed by the parent/guardian and student before participating in any activity, practice, or meeting.
- Group size will be limited to 10 people.
- Scheduling times for practices, activities or meetings should be strictly adhered to.
- Post signs prominently indicating no one should attend or participate in any activity if they currently have symptoms or have been in contact with anyone with a confirmed COVID-19 diagnosis in the last 14 days.
- Masks are recommended to be worn by students and advisors.
- To enter the building, students and advisors should use the door closest to the room that is being used. (Example: If entering the band room the doorway next to the band room would be used.)
- No locker rooms may be used. There will be a designated bathroom that will be open.
- Students should not congregate in the hallways.
- No food will be allowed.
- Parents must remain in their cars or drop off and pick up students after activity, meeting, or practice. Drop off should be no earlier than 5 minutes before scheduled start time.
- Students should use their equipment as much as possible. (Bring your own instrument, notebook, etc. if possible).
- Advisors are responsible for ensuring social distancing is maintained between students as much as possible. Students must bring their own water/beverage to consume during and after practice. No shared drinking fountains, portable hydration stations, or coolers may be used.
- Advisors must sanitize shared equipment before and after each use.
- Advisors must wipe down tables and chairs before and after each use.
- Students and advisors should check their temperatures before attending practices, activities, or meetings.
- Anyone with symptoms of illness is not allowed to practice, activities, or meetings.

- Advisors should be knowledgeable of their students with pre-existing health conditions and work with school nurses or other health officials to take additional precautions as needed.
- Students should be encouraged to provide their own hand sanitizer.
- Advisors must ban spitting and chewing gum.
- Advisors are responsible for tracking absences for the purpose of noting potential COVID-19 cases.
- Contact public health if a positive case of COVID-19 is reported.
