Effective, Tuesday September 8, 2020, all students of the Mineral Point Unified School District participating in the district's food service program will receive breakfast and lunch for free. This is possible because the USDA released COVID-19: Child Nutrition Program Responses #48-56, providing nationwide waivers for the Summer Food Service Program (SFSP) and the National School Lunch Program's Seamless Summer Option (SSO). These waivers extend through December 31, 2020 or until funding runs out.

Students who participate in the food service program on the days they are present in the school building will not be charged for breakfast or lunch. Families who wish to have meals provided for virtual days, including students who are 100% virtual, should register by filling out the [Meal Program for Virtual Learning Days form](#). If you have already registered for the Meal Program for Virtual Learning Days you do not need to register again.

Families who have children enrolled 100% virtually will be able to pick up meals on Wednesdays from 11:30-12:30 outside of the high school. Families who have children that participate in the hybrid schedule will have their meals sent home with the oldest child in the family on the last day that the child attends that week.
