



FILLING BOARD VACANCIES

In the event that a vacancy occurs on the Board for any reason, it shall be filled by appointment by the remaining members. Such appointees shall hold office until a successor is elected and takes office under s.120.06(4), 120.43(6) or 120.73(1). When a vacancy occurs in the office of a Board member who is in the last year of his or her term or when a vacancy occurs after the spring election but on or before the last Tuesday in November, in the office of a Board member who is not in the last year of his or her term, the successor shall be elected at the next spring election. When a vacancy occurs after the last Tuesday in November and on or before the date of the next spring election, in the office of a Board member who is not in the last year of his or her term, the successor shall be elected at the 2nd following spring election.

Any person so appointed and upon being notified of his selection, shall be deemed to have accepted the same unless within five (5) days thereafter he/she files with the clerk or president a written refusal to serve. All such appointments shall be made no later than the next regularly scheduled meeting of the Board.

The office of the School Board Member shall become or be deemed vacant upon the events as provided for in Wisconsin Statutes 17.03, (1)-(13).
