



**POLICY DEVELOPMENT**

The Board shall provide policy statements for the discretionary action of those to whom it delegates authority. These policies shall form the basis of the operation of the school year.

Any member of the Board or the District Administrator may recommend the adoption or revision of a policy. Any such recommended policy adoption or revision shall be submitted to the Board for consideration and discussion at any official meeting of the Board, but shall not be acted upon until the next official meeting following. New policies or policy revisions must be acted upon by the Board in official session and so recorded in the minutes of the meeting. Policies become official and in force upon adoption by a majority of the members present at the Board meeting.
