



SCHOOL DISTRICT LEGAL STATUS

According to Wisconsin State Constitution and Statutes, local school districts are created for the purpose of executing the educational policy as defined in the Constitution and by the state laws passed by succeeding legislative sessions.

The corporate title of the school district is Mineral Point Unified School District. The district is organized as a unified school district, grades Pre-K through twelve, and is governed by the laws relating to unified school districts.
